On the last day, that great day of Sukkot, Yeshua stood and cried out saying, “If anyone thirsts, let him come to Me and drink. He who believes in Me, as the Scripture has said, out of his heart will flow rivers of living water.”

Then behold, they brought to Him a paralytic lying on a bed. When Yeshua saw their faith, He said to the paralytic, “Son be of good cheer, your sins are forgiven you.” At once some of the scribes said within themselves, “this Man blasphemes!” But Yeshua, knowing their thoughts, said, “Why do you think evil in your hearts? Mattiyahu 9:2-8.

And Yochanan, calling two of his talmidim, sent them to Yeshua asking. "Are You the Coming One, or do we look for another?" When the men had come to Him, they said, Yochanan HaMatbiel *[The Immerser or Baptizer]* has sent us to You saying, "Are you the Coming One, or do we look for another."

And that very hour He cured many of infirmities, afflictions, and evil spirits; and to many blind He gave sight. Yeshua answered and said to them, "Go and tell Yochanan the things you have seen and heard; that the blind see, the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, the poor have the gospel preached to them, and blessed is he who is not offended because of Me."

Luke 7:19-23

[The above are the signs Mashiach must do, the Anointed One of God].

"The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected by the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised the third day."

Luke 9:22.

"You search the Scriptures, for in them you think you have eternal life; and these are they which testify of Me. But you are not willing to come to Me that you may have life."

while he blessed them that He was parted from them and carried up into Heaven. And they worshipped Him, and returned to Yerushalayim with great joy, and were continually in the Temple praising and blessing God. Amen.
